

Admission to universities in Western countries has become one step closer, the standardized test for proficiency in the school program SAT (Scholastic assessment test) can now be taken online. This was reported by CollegeBoard, the institution responsible for administering this exam. According to the organizers, the pilot launch of the digital version of the exam showed the same accuracy as the paper test, but at the same time the time required and the volume of texts in the academic reading section were reduced.
