Belarus Intends to Expand Business Cooperation with Turkmenistan

On November 26, Sergei Pristavko, Head of the Freight Operations and Foreign Economic Activities Department of the Belarusian Railway, spoke at the forum "International Transport and Transit Corridors: Interconnection and Development" (ITTC-2024) in Ashgabat.
