

The new generation BMW M5 has made its debut in Russia. The all-wheel-drive sedan of the seventh generation is reported to be equipped with a 727 hp engine and a 4.4-liter capacity paired with an automatic transmission. The car also features a light sensor that responds to lighting conditions and turns on the headlights, as well as a rain sensor that detects precipitation and activates the windshield wipers.

The car alarm key fob allows for remote control of the vehicle, and the anti-theft protection locks the car during movement. The modern multimedia system includes voice control, navigation, wireless charging for smartphones, a 12V socket, a premium audio system, as well as Bluetooth, CarPlay, and USB.



The five-seat leather interior features height-adjustable seats with lumbar support, a panoramic roof, a heated steering wheel, and decorative lighting. The car is equipped with a stabilization system, air conditioning, climate control, and an onboard computer.
