

On November 26, at the conference "International Transport and Transit Corridors: Interconnection and Development 2024" (ITTC-2024) in Ashgabat, Umberto de Pretto, Secretary General of the International Road Transport Union (IRU), spoke.

Umberto de Pretto addressed the modern challenges facing the transport sector. Among them, the IRU leader mentioned the training of qualified personnel and air pollution. He noted that the transport sector has committed to reducing carbon dioxide emissions to zero by 2030.
