

USAID HOSTS HACKATHON IN ASHGABAT TO STRENGTHEN  
TURKMENISTAN'S STARTUP ECOSYSTEM

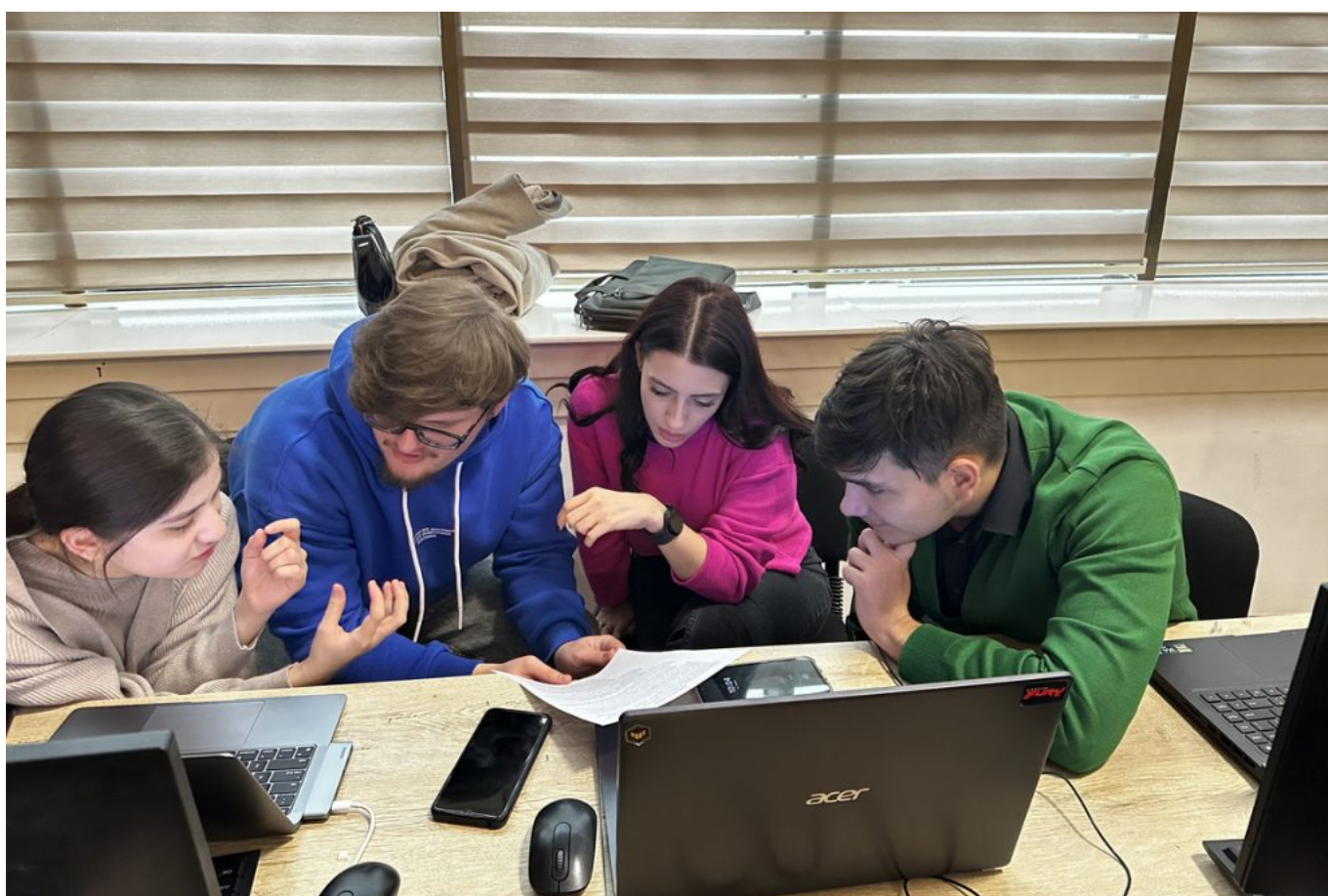
**December 8, 2024, Ashgabat, Turkmenistan** - The U.S. Agency for International Development (USAID), in collaboration with Netijelilik (MCT Agency), hosted a hackathon in Ashgabat on December 7-8, 2024. The event brought together 67 talented web developers, designers, and IT specialists from across Turkmenistan, offering a unique platform for young professionals to collaborate and showcase their creativity in the sphere of information and communications technology (ICT).



During the event, participants were organized into 15 teams and challenged to develop practical solutions for automating business processes based on real-world cases. Teams presented their final projects to a panel of judges consisting of ICT experts, investors, and business leaders. After careful consideration of such factors as creativity, technical feasibility, and presentation quality, the judges awarded first place to the Team "Mekanly Group" for the project "Miwe Monitoring"; second place to "DarkNet" for project "Hasyl"; and third place to "Not Found" with the project "AgriGo". The panel provided constructive feedback to all teams and encouraged participants to continue to pursue entrepreneurship.

This hackathon is part of the MCT Agency's grants program, which strengthens Turkmenistan's startup ecosystem with support from USAID.
