

The International Atomic Energy Agency (IAEA), the World Health Organization (WHO) and Turkmenistan are working together to improve the safe and effective use of nuclear medicine in health care. As part of this effort, a pre-imPACT mission is being conducted in Turkmenistan as a critical step in assessing and strengthening the country's cancer control capacity.
