

Recently, in an interview with <u>"Kanal Avrupa"</u> TV channel, Derya Soysal, a member of the Belgian Institute Diplomatic World, correspondent for Bruxelles Korner, and an independent environmental expert specializing in Central Asian history, highlighted Turkmenistan's unique position and diplomatic influence.
