

Apple will avoid an EU fine over browser settings on iPhones.

The European Commission's investigation began in March 2023. Regulators were concerned that the web browser choice interface in iOS hindered users from easily switching to alternative search engines and browsers. However, after the changes made, the EU is likely to close the investigation next week.

The DMA law aims to limit the influence of large tech companies and create equal conditions for competition. It requires users to freely choose services and applications, and companies violating these rules may face fines of up to 10% of their annual revenue.
