

A meeting was held between the Chairperson of the Mejlis of Turkmenistan and the Secretary General of the Inter-Parliamentary Union

During a working visit to the Republic of Uzbekistan, a delegation led by the Chairperson of the Mejlis of Turkmenistan met with the Secretary General of the Inter-Parliamentary Union, Martin Chungong.

During the meeting, the importance of the adoption of the UN General Assembly Resolutions initiated by Turkmenistan — "2025 – The Year of International Peace and Trust," "On the Permanent Neutrality of Turkmenistan," and other initiatives put forward by our country to ensure peace and security throughout the world — was emphasized.

The Chairperson of the Mejlis of Turkmenistan, D.
