

Reuters, citing its sources, reports that the technical team of the Government Efficiency Department (DOGE), led by Elon Musk, allegedly uses artificial intelligence to study communications in a federal agency to identify dissatisfaction with President Trump.

The activities of this group are mostly confidential, and almost nothing is known about them. Reuters stated that the use of AI to detect disloyalty "raises concerns about privacy and government ethics." These specialists allegedly use the Signal messenger for communication, making their correspondence untraceable.

They are also reportedly actively using the Grok AI chatbot in their work to reduce costs and improve the efficiency of the federal government. However, details about the specific functionality of Grok AI are not disclosed.
