

The American startup Atonemo has introduced the Streamplayer, a tiny Wi-Fi adapter designed for stereo systems that lack built-in smart features

The device resembles a Zippo lighter and connects via a 3.5 mm jack. Price: \$99. Streamplayer supports AirPlay 2, Google Cast, Spotify Connect, and Tidal Connect.

It is compatible with both iOS and Android, does not require a separate app, and works with the user's favorite streaming services. The device is equipped with a DAC supporting audio up to 24-bit/192 kHz, Bluetooth LE Audio, Wi-Fi 6, and USB-C for power.

Atonemo CEO Leo Ballesteros describes the gadget as an "Apple TV for audio systems"—a simple way to give a second life to beloved speakers without being tied to ecosystems or brands. Sales are expected to start in spring.
