

On May 7, the UEFA Champions League semi-final featured a clash between Italian **Inter** and Spanish **Barcelona**. **Inzaghi’s** squad secured a thrilling 4-3 victory, earning their place in the final (7-6 on aggregate).

Hans-Dieter Flick’s team will play their next match on May 11 in the Spanish league—hosting Madrid’s **Real**, their main rival in the title race.

Spanish media reported that **Los Blancos** closely followed their opponent’s exit from European competition and believe **Barcelona** has “fallen into a deep psychological hole.”

“It will hurt them. This is our chance to get closer to winning the championship,” Madrid’s club is confident. If **Real** defeats their rival, they will close the gap to just one point behind Barcelona.
