The meeting of the Turkmen-Saudi Inter-parliamentary friendship group was held via videoconference

On May 12, 2025, representatives of the Mejlis of Turkmenistan participated in a meeting of the Turkmen-Saudi Inter-parliamentary friendship group, was held via videoconference.

During the meeting, the participants were introduced to the main directions of Turkmenistan's internal and external policy, based on the principles of positive neutrality, peacefulness, equality, humanism, mutually beneficial cooperation, to the structure of the Mejlis, as well as to the multifaceted work carried out to ensure the legal basis for the program reforms being implemented in the country.
