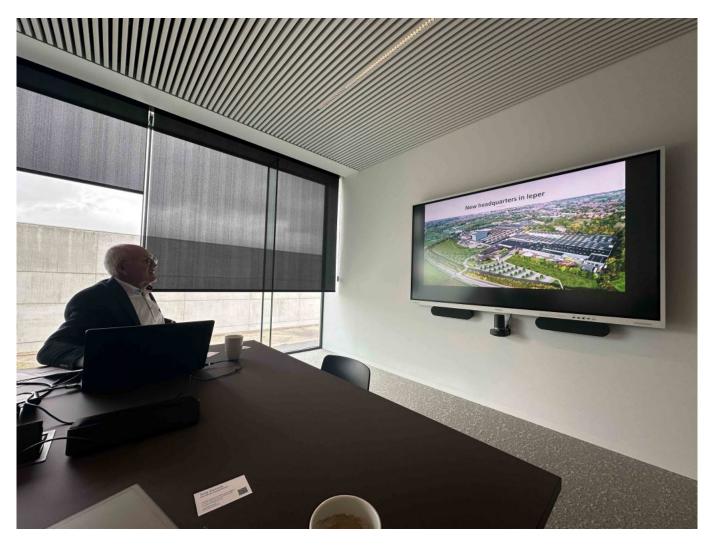


As part of strengthening **trade and economic cooperation** between Turkmenistan and the Kingdom of Belgium, a **delegation led by Turkmenistan's Minister of Textile Industry, Nurmuhammet Orazgeldiyev**, paid a working visit to **Ypres, Belgium**, where the headquarters of the **global textile machinery leader Picanol** is located.



On behalf of Belgium, the Turkmen delegation was welcomed by **Tony Decocq**, sales director of weaving machines at Picanol. During the meeting, he gave a **detailed presentation** on the company's history and development, from its foundation to its current progress.
