

On June 10, 2025, Azerbaijan's Prime Minister **Ali Asadov** arrived in **Tashkent** for an official visit, where he met with Uzbekistan's President **Shavkat Mirziyoyev**. The two leaders discussed the future of friendly relations and strategic partnership between their countries.
