## A humanoid robot was created in China, cheaper than two Apple Vision Pro

The Chinese company Unitree introduced the new Robot R1. He knows how to make a somersault, run, stand in his arms and recognize voice teams – and all this is for \$5,900, which is cheaper than two Apple Vision Pro helmets.

R1 almost growth per person weighs 25 kg and looks like a hero from the Mighty Rangers. In the robot, II for recognition of images and speech. Unlike the previous G1, R1 model, it is easier and almost twice cheaper. He has 26 movable joints: 6 in the legs, 5 in each hand, 2 in the head and 2 in the waist.

Although R1 is not yet intended for home use. Previously, Unitree, but she held a tournament with the participation of her robots.
