

The startup Greptile, which created artificial intelligence to check the software code, is negotiating investments in the amount of about \$ 30 million. According to sources, the cost of the company is estimated at about \$ 180 million. Investments can be headed by the Benchmark venture fund.

The company was founded in 2023 by Daksh Gupta after graduating from the Technological Institute of Georgia. At the end of 2023, Greptile was an accelerator of the Y Combinator and attracted \$ 4 million at the sowing of the Initialized Capital.

AI understands the customer code and helps to find errors and other problems that people can skip.

The AI market for checking the code is very competitive. The main rivals of Greptile are startups Graphite and Coderabbit. And they have already received large investments from well-known funds.

Greptile and Benchmark have not yet commented on the situation.
