

Galaxy S26 Edge will be thinner than its predecessor, but will receive a larger battery

The next year, Samsung will release the Galaxy S26 Edge smartphone, which will become even thinner than the predecessor. But at the same time, the novelty will receive a more capacious battery.

This was announced by the famous insider ICE Universe. According to the leak, the device will use a new technology of battery materials, presumably silicon-carbon, which will increase the capacity without growth in basements.

For comparison, the Galaxy S25 Edge presented in the spring impressed only 5.8 mm thick, but users complained about the battery - it was only 3900 mAh. By current standards, this is a rather modest indicator, especially in the flagship segment.

The new Galaxy S26 EDGE, according to rumors, will lose this drawback, while maintaining the record subtlety of the case.

The device will be released in a competitive environment: this year the release of the iPhone 17 Air, as well as new ultra -thin models from Chinese brands, is expected. Samsung has to prove that the thin case and decent autonomy can be combined in one device.
