

In Apple Cards, after updating to iOS 26, the function “visited places” will appear

The Apple Maps in the Beta version of iOS 26 received improvements, including the new Liquid Glass design and the recovery function. Among the innovations are the “visited places” function, which helps to memorize places and view them in the application.

However, this function is available only by the request, as it is protected by through encryption, and so far is only available in the United States. In beta testing, errors may occur.

To access the “visited places” you need to open Apple Maps, click on the profile, select “places” and “visited places”. Here you can view places by categories and cities, save them in the guidebook, add notes, evaluate and delete. If the Apple Maps is mistaken with the location, you can press the “wrong location” and choose another place or institution.

According to the 9TO5MAC portal, the “visited places” function will be useful for traveling trips, especially in new cities: the route will be saved for re -visit. The function is integrated with the iPhone, ensures data security and works in the background.

“In Apple Maps, the “visited places” function helps users remember the places where they have visited. Users can configure the iPhone so that it determines whether they are in any place, for example, in a restaurant or store, and displayed all the places they have visited in the card application. The “visited places” function is protected by through encryption, and Apple cannot get access to it, ”the function of the function on the Apple website said.
