

In Russia, they demanded to ban the warehouses of marketplaces in residential buildings due to complaints

Marketplais warehouses located in residential buildings caused complaints from the Russians. Senator Oleg Golov turned to Rospotrebnadzor with a proposal to develop special rules for such objects. According to him, residential buildings, especially the old building, are initially not designed for warehouse activities.

Residents of apartment buildings complain of constant unloading of goods that lead to a deterioration in air quality due to exhaust gases and other inconveniences. In addition, the intensive flow of freight transport complicates the movement in the yards, making it difficult to enter and exit cars, writes 360.ru.

The senator noted that he received many appeals from dissatisfied citizens who experience serious inconvenience due to the work of warehouses in residential quarters. He proposed to consider the possibility of moving such objects into separate non-residential buildings, which could significantly improve the situation.

At the same time, Golov emphasized that we are not talking about creating problems for business. He insists on finding a compromise that will maintain the work of darcsters and at the same time ensure the comfort and safety of residents of houses.
