

Kingisepp plant will begin the production of engines for ocean vessels

The Kingisepp Machine -Building Plant (KMZ), which has recently been part of a combined shipbuilding corporation, will develop 10 MW ship engines. These installations are intended for large ocean tankers, gas carriers and balcony.

Earlier, KMZ worked mainly for state defense order, releasing boats for the military and sea drones. Now the main goal of the enterprise will be the creation of low -speed engines of the world class, combining efficiency and efficiency. The plant experts expect to further increase the power of produced engines.

According to the leadership, the practice of manufacturing such attitudes will ensure shipbuilding technological independence. This is the first case for many years when domestic industry will be able to offer high -power engines comparable to foreign analogues.
