

Putin said that Russia is not behind the development of AI

President Vladimir Putin noted the significant successes of Russia in the development of artificial intelligence. At a meeting with Sberian Gref, he said that the country not only caught up with competitors, but also in some areas came ahead.

Since April 1, the Russian II model Gigachat has become available for wide use. According to Gref, according to key parameters, it is included in the five best world analogues, demonstrating comparable and sometimes superior results.

Particular attention was paid to innovations in the field of payments. Russia has developed unique terminals that combine payment by QR code, biometric data and bank cards. According to Gref, there are no such decisions in any other country.

The head of Sberbank emphasized that Gigachat is already actively used by both private users and business. This confirms the demand for domestic developments in the field of artificial intelligence.
