

Residents of Krasnogorsk have mastered sappboards for movement along flooded streets

In Krasnogorsk, residents of the New Riga residential complex came up with an original way to move along the streets during bad weather – they use sapphboards. These boards for walking on water and dirt allow you to easier to go around large puddles and not get wet.

According to eyewitnesses, the water level on the streets reached approximately 15 centimeters – exactly so much, judging by the flooded light car, can be seen in the video. Despite small inconveniences, for example, it is difficult to keep the phone on the sappingboard, users consider this method of movement quite acceptable, writes 360.ru.

A sharp deterioration in the weather is associated with heavy rains, which during the night and morning fell in some areas of the Moscow region in a volume exceeding the monthly norm. In Zelenograd, for example, 91 millimeters of precipitation were recorded at a norm of 85 millimeters.

In addition, in Krasnogorsk, an underpass at the Pavlyno MCD-2 station was seriously injured-it was flooded almost to the ceiling. Because of this, many passers-by were forced to take off their shoes.
