

AMD will reveal plans for Zen 6, RDNA 5 and AI already on November 11 at a special presentation

AMD confirmed the holding of Financial Analyst Day 2025, which will be held on November 11 in New York.

At the event, the company will present long-term plans for the development of CPU, GPU and solutions for AI, as well as update the financial strategy.

The main emphasis is expected at future architectures. According to AMD, EpyC Venice server processors based on Zen 6 will be released in 2026 and offer up to 256 cores. At the November presentation, the company will tell in detail about Zen 6 for consumer PCs for the first time, and also affect the further generations Zen 7 and Zen 8.

In the graphic direction, the details of the RDNA 5 and the future architecture of RDNA 6 are expected, where AMD can combine gaming and professional GPUs. Also, the development plans for the Instinct MI500 for AI and HPC, which will change the current MI400 accelerators to the CDNA NEXT.

At the same time, AMD will share a network map of network solutions, including Vulcano maps with a support for 800 GBE, and the packaging plans for high-performance systems.
