

Apple confirmed that Samsung would supply chips from the plant in Texas

Apple announced that Samsung Electronics will supply chips produced at the company in Texas for Apple products, including the iPhone. The company's statement said that these chips will be optimized in terms of energy consumption and performance for Apple equipment.

The representative of Samsung refused to comment on this issue.

This statement sounded against the backdrop of Apple's announcements about plans to increase investments in the United States by \$ 100 billion, which would bring a total amount of investment in the country to \$ 600 billion over the next four years.

Previously, Tesla entered into a contract with Samsung in the amount of \$ 16.5 billion for the supply of chips. The head of Tesla, Elon Musk, said that the new Samsung factory in Texas would produce the next generation of AI6 chip for the company.
