

Briefing on the Priority Positions of Turkmenistan at the 80th Session of the UN General Assembly was held in the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Turkmenistan

On August 30, 2025, the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Turkmenistan hosted a briefing on the Priority Positions of Turkmenistan at the successive, 80th session of the United Nations General Assembly.

Among the participants of the briefing there were the leadership and staff members of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Turkmenistan, heads and representatives of diplomatic missions and representative offices of international organizations accredited in Ashgabat, as well as representatives of the national mass media.
