

Following smartphones, Samsung smart refrigerators will receive One UI and 7 years of updates

Samsung announced that the proprietary ONE UI shell will go beyond smartphones and TVs and will appear in the household appliances of the company with Wi-Fi and built-in screens. For example, on “smart” refrigerators and washing machines.

This will unify the interface on all devices and add support for popular applications and services in the Samsung ecosystem. The company notes that the purpose of the initiative is to create a single and intuitive user experience: the usual smartphone interface will now be available on large household appliances.

In addition, Samsung confirmed that such devices will receive software updates within seven years from the date of entry into the market. The promise applies to equipment released since 2024.

The first updates with new functions will begin to arrive in September 2025.

Thus, Samsung relies on long-term support of household electronics, bringing it in terms of service level to smartphones.
