

In Russia, they will present a “White Book” on the introduction of AI
into transport

The Russian transport industry prepared the White Book on the introduction of artificial intelligence (AI). The presentation of the document will be held on October 1 at the Digital Transport forum, which takes place under the auspices of the Ministry of Transport.

According to Yevgeny Charkin, Deputy Head of Russian Railways, the transport industry became the first in Russia to complete the development of such a document. The White Book contains recommendations and approaches to the use of artificial intelligence technologies in the transport system.

Earlier it became known that in the Moscow metro they plan [Launch](#) The first trains without driver already at the end of 2026. This was told by Moscow Mayor Sergei Sobyenin, noting that preparations for the innovation are in full swing. At the same time, Russian Railways experts develop similar technologies for the Moscow Central Ring and Central Diameters.
