In the UK, they stopped demanding from Apple to reveal the encryption iCloud

Apparently, even "heavy artillery" was attracted to protect Apple in the UK. The fact that Britain stopped demanding from Apple to open the encryption of the ICLOD cloud service, said the head of the US -BBT -exploration Tulsey Gabbard.

She announced that the British government revoked the demand for access to the encrypted icloud data. Great Britain abandoned plans to force Apple to provide a "black move" (backdor) for access to data, and this would affect everyone, including the Americans. However, this information has not yet been confirmed by Apple itself.

Previously, the UK used the law on the powers of the investigating authorities (IPA) to demand access to encrypted data in ICLUD. Apple removed the function of expanded data protection in the UK instead of violation of security standards, and then appel herself, which forced the British Ministry of Internal Affairs to reveal the details of the request.

The requirement of Great Britain caused disputes, as it required access to users without the knowledge of their governments. Probably, the United States put pressure on the UK to reconsider the position.
