

In India, they presented the new Infinix GT 30 smartphone, focused on games. The device is distinguished by a design with a white LED backlight on the rear panel and gaming triggers on the case.

The smartphone is equipped with a 6.78-inch AMOLED display with a resolution of 1224P, a renewal frequency of 144 Hz and a brightness of up to 4,500 threads. The screen is protected by Gorilla Glass 7i glass, there is a print scanner under the screen and has a hole under a 13-MP front camera. The main camera Sony IMX682 and 8-MP super-ricked ones are installed behind the 64-MP.

At the basis - the MediaTek Dimensity 7400 processor, 8 GB of RAM LPDDR5x and up to 256 GB of built-in memory UFS 2.2. A smartphone on Android 15 works with the XOS 15 shell. The manufacturer promises two years of OS updates and three years of security updates.

For games, triggers are provided, a cooling system with a 6-layer steam chamber and customizable backlight. The battery with a capacity of 5500 mAh supports 45 watts charging. There is protection against spray according to the IP64 standard, weight - 187.

Sales in India will start on August 14. The colors of Cyber Blue, Pulse Green and Blade White are available. Price - from 19,499 rupees (\$ 220) for a version of 8/128 GB and 20,999 rupees (\$ 240) for 8/256 GB.
