

Android Authority insiders said that after many rumors and leaks, the question of the availability of physical SIM cards in the Google Pixel 10 model remains open. Against this background, the Evan Blasser has published a new image in most of the X-account, showing that there are no slot for most models of the Pixel 10 line SIM cards.

Earlier, Blass said that the Pixel 10, 10 Pro and 10 Pro XL will not have a slot for a SIM card, and, apparently, this was confirmed. The insider shared a photograph of the label from the packaging of a smartphone, which indicates: "You no longer need a physical SIM card. Activate ESIM while setting up the phone. " Given that this photo is accompanied by a quote of its previous leak, we can assume that the label really refers to Pixel 10.

According to previous forecasts, bass, the only device in the line that will save the slot for a physical SIM card will be the Pixel 10 Pro Fold-a folding model. As noted, the new marking confirms the initial information, although the wording leaves a place for doubt. If the user “no longer needs” the physical SIM card, this clearly indicates ESIM support. The text does not directly say that there is no slot for a SIM card, but this can be assumed, so observers summarize their material.
