

Intel head began negotiations with the US authorities after Trump's demand to resign

Intel General Lip-bo Tang said that the company is negotiating with the US administration to clarify the issues and provide reliable information. This happened after President Donald Trump demanded his immediate resignation.

Earlier, Donald Trump demanded the resignation of Intel General Director Lip-bo Tana. He made the corresponding statement on the social network Truth Social, which he owns. Trump said that the head of the corporation is in a situation of acute conflict of interest, which, in his opinion, requires urgent actions.

Lip-bo Tang headed Intel in March, replacing Pat Gelsinger-under him the company was experiencing a fall in the shares and a lag in the field of artificial intelligence. Initially, the purpose of the new CEO was evaluated optimistic: the shares increased by 15%.
