

Judging by certification in China, Honor Magic 8 will partially lose 100 watts charging

The Honor Magic 8 series is preparing to launch and has already passed the obligatory Chinese certification 3C. Two models with BKQ-AN00 and BKQ-AN80 numbers appeared in the database. Both smartphones support the BEIDOU satellite communication and will be the first devices in China with the Snapdragon 8 Elite 2 processor to receive this certificate.

Suddenly, the characteristics indicate the wired charging with a capacity of 90 watts, and not 100 W, like the past Magic 7 and Pro. According to rumors, this may mean that 90 watts will have the alleged compact version of Magic 8 Mini, while the standard and Pro-models will retain 100-watt charging.

Earlier, insiders reported that Honor is preparing a mini-smartphone with a screen of 6.3 inches. However, other sources denied this information. Now, certification data indirectly confirm the possibility of the appearance of such a version.

In addition, the development of the Magic 8 Ultra model is in development.
