

The Windows Latest portal said that many Windows 10 users after installing the August update KB5063709 began to receive intrusive and annoying notifications that support for this system will end soon. Notifications literally pop up on ordinary computer and virtual environments.

Observers with reference to social networks indicate that, probably, it is about almost all Windows 10 users, because there are a lot of people about these notifications.

Such obsession with Microsoft is explained by the fact that official support for Windows 10 will end on October 14, 2025. After that, users will not be able to receive technical support and safety renewal. As an alternative, the company offers to switch to Windows 11, which can be downloaded immediately or planning the installation.

However, in this advertising Windows 11 there is a share of cunning: owners of Windows 10 will be able to continue to receive updates after October 14th. In July, Microsoft launched the Extended Security Updates (ESU) program, which gives access to safety updates for a whole year. For this, it is necessary to synchronize OneDrive and accounting Microsoft. You can also buy an annual subscription for security patches for \$ 30.
