

Microsoft tests the new function “My applications” in the Xbox application for Windows 11. It will allow players to quickly find, install and run third-party programs, browsers and shops directly from the Xbox application. Without the need to open Microsoft Store or look for installers manually.

As Devin Dhalival explained, Xbox products manager, the new tab combines all gaming applications in one place. The media write that this is done exactly under the fast release of the portable Rog Xbox Ally, where you want to minimize the use of the usual Windows desktop. The console, recall, comes out on October 16.

At the moment, applications like Battle.net, Chrome and Gog Galaxy are available in the test. Microsoft plans to expand the list over time.
