

In the last August update, Microsoft eliminated numerous vulnerabilities in the Windows security system. We are talking about 107 vulnerabilities, 13 of which are recognized as critical.

The update is designed for all current versions of Windows, including Windows 10, Windows 11 and Windows Server.

Additionally, Microsoft made modifications to the Windows security system in order to prevent potential failures in Crowdstrike. The update eliminates vulnerabilities in the key components of Windows, such as the "conductor", a remote desktop and Hyper-V. Errors in Microsoft Office, Edge and Teams applications were also fixed.

Of the 13 critical vulnerabilities, 9 are associated with the possibility of remote code execution, which poses a threat to the zero day; This is the vulnerability of the CVE-2025-53779.
