

Pixel 10 Pro Fold has become thicker and harder - and that's all you need to know about the "novelty"

Google is preparing to present the Pixel 10 series, and, judging by the leaks, the Pixel 10 Pro Fold model will greatly disappoint users.

Instead of progress, the company seems to have limited itself to updating the characteristics, making the device thicker (10.8 mm) and heavier (258 g) of the previous model. This is especially noticeable against the background of competitors: Galaxy Z Fold 7 from Samsung weighs 215 g with a thickness of 8.9 mm.

Yes, an enlarged battery, fast charging and QI2 support is expected, as well as an important innovation - protection by IP68 standard, for the first time among folding smartphones.

However, otherwise, the novelty does not offer a significant breakthrough: the design has not changed, and hardware innovations are not impressive.

Against the background of growing competition and high price (~ \$ 1800), Pixel 10 Pro Fold may seem outdated already at the start.

Instead of radically improved the model or reduce the price of the previous one, Google seems to take a step back - and it is still unclear for whom this smartphone has been created at all.
