

Vivo introduced its new V60 medium -chief smartphone in India. The main features of the device are a triple camera with ZEISS support and a 6.500 mAh battery.

The main camera includes three modules: 50 megapixels of the Sony IMX882 television cabinet with OIS and 3X optical zoom, 50 megapixel main sensor Sony IMX766 with OIS and 8 MP ultra -large -angled module. Ahead is a 50 megapixel chamber with a viewing angle of 92 °. There is a LED flash, and different AI-mode.

AMOLED display with a diagonal of 6.77 inches, Full HD+, 120 Hz and a brightness of up to 5,000 threads. The print scanner is built into the screen. V60 supports fast charging 90 watts.

The heart of the phone was Snapdragon 7 Gen 4 C to 16 GB of RAM and up to 512 GB of memory. The smartphone uses cooling with a steam chamber and works on Android 15 with Funtouch OS 15. OS updates will be released for 4 years, and security will be 6 years.

There is an IP68/IP69, support for two SIM, recording video in 4K and AI Google Gemini.
