

Russians were reminded of a fine for a refrigerator thrown out in the garbage

Lawyer Mikhail Salkin told News.ru that if you leave an old refrigerator or other bulky garbage at a landfill, next to garbage tanks, you can get a fine. The amount of the fine can be from 2000 to 3000 rubles.

The cause of the fine is not only in the very fact of leaving such things on the trash, but also a violation of environmental legislation.

According to the law, if you throw a large garbage, which belongs to large household appliances, including refrigerators, next to garbage tanks, this is considered a violation. It is precisely for this that you will have to pay from 2000 to 3000 rubles.

This also applies to nature protection. For this, a fine can be from 1000 to 2000 rubles.

The requirements of the law are such that things like a refrigerator need to be disposed of, giving it to a special company. They will take it for money, usually from 600 rubles or more.
