

The Rustore app store has introduced a new function-public beta testing. This tool allows developers to attract users to check programs before their official access to the store.

Now, the authors of the applications are enough to load the trial assembly into the special section of the Rustore console and arrange its card. After that, they receive a link to invite testers. By crossing it, users can install beta versions and start using it.

All feedback from testers, including reviews and comments, is sent directly to the developer and is not published in general access. It is important that estimates and ratings received during the beta test do not affect the public application card after its official release. This allows you to eliminate errors without risking the reputation of the product.

According to representatives of the platform, such a system is useful for everyone. The developers get the opportunity to collect valuable statistics and correct critical shortcomings until wide launch. Users, in turn, earlier gain access to new products and can affect their final quality.

In addition to public testing, the function of closed or alpha testing remains in Rustore. It is designed to check the applications with a narrow circle of pre -selected users.
