

Recently, Samsung introduced new models of the Galaxy Watch 8 smart hours. But it was stated that the company’s specialists are already working on the creation of new models- Galaxy Watch 9 and 10.

At a recent press conference, the representative of Samsung compared the products of the Korean vendor with the analogues of Chinese manufacturers. He emphasized how the company’s approach differs from the approach of competitors.

In an interview with the Korean media, the Samsung manager Choi John Min, the executive director of the medical equipment group that is part of the Samsung Mobile Experience unit, said the company pays special attention to user experience when using Galaxy Watch devices. And he commented on a longer autonomy of wearable devices produced for the Chinese market.

Speaking about competition from Chinese brands, Ming noted that Chinese manufacturers, of course, strive to increase their share in the market, attracting new buyers. And what Samsung pays priority to increase the service life and increase the performance of smart watches throughout the entire period of use.

In response to questions about progress achieved by Chinese brands in the field of energy-efficient systems, Choi John Ming said that these smart hours use low-energy chips that provide autonomous work for 7-10 days. The manager explained the smaller autonomy of the Samsung watch with many unique and photosensitive sensors, including the antioxidant index sensor.
