

Samsung will change the design of the Galaxy S26 Ultra, making the corners even "softer"

Samsung continues to change the design of its flagship line Ultra. According to the ICE Universe insider, the future Galaxy S26 Ultra will receive even more rounded angles than the S25 Ultra, which has already abandoned the sharp "laout -like" Galaxy S24 Ultra faces.

Thus, the smartphone will become more convenient to lie in the hand, eliminating the main minus of past models – the corners absorbed into the palm of your hand. The screen will also change a little: the diagonal will increase from 6.86 to 6.89 inches due to a decrease in the framework, without growth of the case.

In addition, according to rumors, Samsung will return the "island" to the main cameras – the main sensor, a width and a telephoto at 5x – to free up a place for larger and advanced modules.

Galaxy S26 Ultra can become thinner and easier than its predecessor, gets the Snapdragon 8 Elite Gen 2 chip and a new memory. Flex magic pixel technology is separately mentioned, which obscures the screen at an angle and protects against peeping.

Thus, Samsung is gradually moving away from Note's heritage towards more ergonomic and modern design.
