
Sony prepares a radical simplification of games development for its next console.

In new patents, the company describes the replacement of the usual girlfriends with compact PCIE payments that can be inserted into a regular PC or server. Such a card will contain key components of PlayStation and actually turn the computer into a full -fledged girl.

The solution should relieve the main pain of studios: traditional sets for developers are bulky, expensive and produced by limited batches. In contrast, PCIe cards are easier to replicate and use both locally and as part of remote "girls-servers", which can be connected via the Internet.

The bond management between the board and the host system will provide a special Endpoint Management Bridge chip.


