

The portal Tom's Hardware spoke about another implementation of the legendary DOOM game on a non-standard device. Enthusiast Aaron Christopheles launched a classic doom on a desktop charger - a powerful Powerbank - Anker Prime Charger. According to Christopheus, the gadget showed himself better as the "player" of Doom than he expected.

Anker Prime Charger has a capacity of 250 watts, equipped with six USB ports and "smart" Ganprime technology, but 2.26 "display with a resolution of 480 x 200 pixels and a system on a single-critical Synwit SWM34s processor with 8 Mb of SDRAM and 16 MB of SDRAM and 16 MB systems are important to launch DOOM. Flash memory.

Christopheles noted that the DOOM demo version works "completely without hardware modifications" using only the debugging connector on the rear panel of the device for downloading software.
