


Battlefield 6 players may have to delete Valorant due to the antichitis conflict.

According to Reddit users, Antit BF6 - Javelin - blocks the launch of the game if Valorant is installed on the PC with Vanguard antichitis.

When you try to launch, a notification appears about the "incompatibility of the software" with a proposal to remove the conflicting program or change its settings.

The problem is due to the fact that both anti-read work at the level of the system nucleus and require safe loading (Secure Boot), which is why the conflict occurs.

Despite this, Battlefield 6 has already set a record - open beta attracted more than 500,000 simultaneous players in Steam, exceeding the peak indicators of Call of Duty.

Electronic Arts also reported blocking over 330,000 reading attempts during the test. Some analysts believe that BF6 this year will be able to seriously squeeze a competitor.
