

In the Windows 11 operating system, the function of recording individual windows will appear. In the near future, Windows 11 will introduce a new functionality of the “scissors” tool, which will allow not to record the entire screen, but only the selected window. This will be a new function of the Snipping Tool system set.

According to the PCWORLD portal with reference to sources in Microsoft, this innovation is aimed at simplifying the process of creating videos and increasing user work efficiency.

Now, to launch the “Scissors” tool, Windows 11 uses a combination of Windows + Shift + R keys. However, if it is necessary to record a certain screen of the screen, users have encountered subsequent editing recording to remove unnecessary fragments.

Microsoft plans to implement the function of recording specific windows, which will allow users to record only their content that interests them without the need for subsequent recording processing. The function is already available in the latest Windows 11 beta version. The exact release date for the wide audience has not yet been announced with this functionality, but perhaps the update will be distributed at the end of 2025 or early 2026.
