SAN FRANCISCO — Google has officially clarified the user limitations for its AI platform Gemini. These new rules replace previously vague descriptions with transparent daily and monthly usage caps.

These limits help users manage their access more effectively and choose the subscription tier that best suits their needs. For those requiring more creative or research capacity, upgrading to Pro or Ultra unlocks significantly expanded capabilities.

Google representatives stated that the goal of these changes is to ensure service stability and a balanced user experience.
