

The Internet is arranged so that remote materials do not always disappear without a trace. Any of your posts on social networks may find yourself in the archives. Here with what information you need to be especially careful when publishing it.

Documents. Do not photograph and do not post pictures of passports, bank cards, tickets: scammers can easily use all this.

Phone and address. Often the phone number is the key to restoring access to different accounts. If possible, do not report your address or geolocation on social networks.

Habits and personal life. There are cases when pictures from human social networks were on dubious sites.
