

President of Turkmenistan had a meeting with the King of Eswatini on the sidelines of the 80th anniversary session of the UN General Assembly

During his visit to the United States, President Serdar Berdimuhamedov had a meeting with King Mswati III of Eswatini.

After warmly greeting each other, the two expressed satisfaction with the opportunity to meet on the sidelines of the 80th anniversary session of the UN General Assembly and exchange views on the prospects and possible directions for the development of interstate relations.
