

Meeting between the National Leader of the Turkmen people,
Chairman of the Halk Maslahaty of Turkmenistan with the Deputy
Chairman of the Cabinet of Ministers of Afghanistan for Economic
Affairs

On October 20, 2025, during his visit to Afghanistan, the National Leader of the Turkmen people, Chairman of the Halk Maslahaty Gurbanguly Berdimuhamedov met with Deputy Chairman of the Cabinet of Ministers of Afghanistan for Economic Affairs Abdul Ghani Baradar.

Warmly welcoming the National Leader of the Turkmen people, Abdul Ghani Baradar emphasized that Afghanistan highly values its friendly ties with Turkmenistan.

Hero-Arkadag noted with satisfaction the consistent strengthening of bilateral relations based on friendship and good neighborliness.

Abdul Ghani Baradar also once again thanked the Turkmen side for the humanitarian aid regularly sent to Afghanistan.
